Here are some activities that will support your child's learning in school:

- Share books with your child. We will inform you of the book they are listening to and writing about each week.
- Listen to your child read their reading books and send their book to school every day.
- Read and write numbers up to 100 and beyond - learn to write a new number every day.
- Learn by heart these number facts:

$$5 + 4 = 9$$

$$5 + 6 = 11$$

$$6 + 7 = 13$$

$$8 + 7 = 15$$

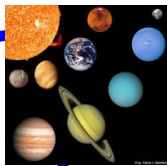

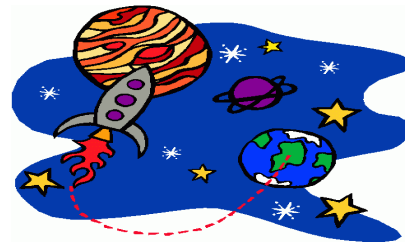

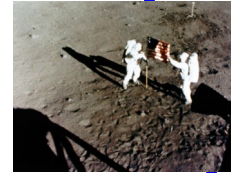
