Here are some activities that will support your child's learning in school:

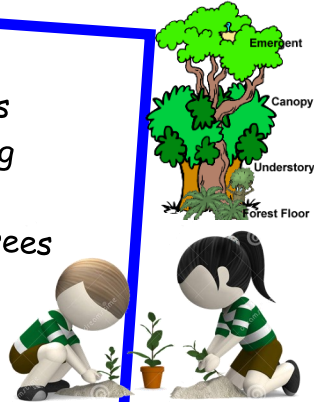
- Talk homework will be set each week. Take time to discuss the talk topic with your child to help prepare them for their 'Big Writing'.
- Share books with your child.
- Listen to your child read and send their book to school every day.
- Write numbers up to 100 and beyond - learn to write a new number every day.
- Practise addition and subtraction pairs of numbers up to 10.
- Learn the 2x, 5x and 10x tables by heart.
- Say aloud the days of the week and months of the year.
- Add and take away two numbers using numbers up to 50.
- Recognise all coins and their values - play shops to encourage giving change.
- Draw shapes with a ruler.
- Measure the length of different objects or lines on a page.
- Colouring in and drawing.
- Write their full name and address.
- Learn the spellings that are sent home each week.
- Use your unique password to log in to the Learning Platform and access a wide range of activities online.
- Use your unique password to log in to Sumdog for reading and maths activities.
