

## Extreme Hairstyles

The following are not acceptable in school

- Mixed colours
- 'V'cuts
- Hair extensions
- Extreme hairstyles (including mohican, cut in patterns and shapes and shaven heads).

Long hair must be tied back for health and safety reasons. It will also help prevent your child from catching headlice.

Children will be provided, if necessary, with a hair band to tie their hair back.

## Accessories

The following are not permitted in school:-

- 'Fake' tattoos
- False nails
- Make-up

## Jewellery

Children are permitted to wear a watch and small stud earrings only.

Necklaces, bracelets etc. are not permitted due to health and safety reasons. It is recommended that children who are having their ears pierced do so at the start of the six weeks holiday.

## Failure to wear uniform

No child will be sent home for not wearing uniform. The child will be given a spare uniform to wear that day and a slip will be sent home reminding parents/carers of the reasons for the uniform policy.

A parent/carer that is struggling to provide a uniform for financial reasons will be given a second hand uniform at no cost.

# School Uniform Policy

## Introduction

School uniform plays an important role in contributing to the ethos of a school and setting an appropriate tone. A uniform can instill pride; support positive behaviour and discipline; ensure pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome and protect children from social pressures to dress in a particular way. Above all research shows that school uniform supports effective teaching and learning.

## Cost

The most important consideration when providing uniform is cost. To enable all parents/carers to afford a uniform the school has a colours only stipulation. Although the school provides branded sweatshirts, parents/carers can shop around for the cheapest possible provider so long as the colours of yellow polo shirt and navy blue jumper cardigan/ sweatshirt are adhered to.

Open Toe Sandals, Gladiator Sandals, Flip Flops, Crocs, Jelly Shoes

Brightly coloured shoes

Shoes with a heel

Trainers

### Footwear

If footwear is considered to be unsuitable then parents/carers will be asked to bring replacements to school. If no contact can be made the child will be provided with a pair of black pumps.

If your child wears boots or wellingtons on the walk to school they need to bring with them a pair of shoes to change into.
